

## Preventing Nuclear Terrorism

Whereas: The accelerating spread of nuclear weapons, nuclear know-how and nuclear material has increased the possibility that the deadliest weapons ever invented could fall into dangerous hands; and

Whereas: Former U.S. officials with extensive experience, including the overwhelming majority of secretaries of state and defense and national security advisors, have advised that steps we are taking now to address this threat are not adequate to the danger; and

Whereas: Retired United States Generals are calling nuclear weapons inherently dangerous, hugely expensive, militarily inefficient and morally indefensible; and

Whereas: The U.S. public has a growing interest and strong positive response to addressing this issue

Therefore be it resolved : That the United States President and Congress make the nuclear terrorism threat America's #1 security priority, and work with other countries and the United Nations to immediately implement actions that will secure fissile material to a high standard and abolish nuclear weapons worldwide.
